

Dear Ladies and Gentlemen,

The EUJÄGER Non Governmental Organization was established in 2007 and was initiated by László Bozóki for the goal to promote the Culture of Hunting in Europe with leaflets and printed handouts which are currently not present on the market.

As part of this effort I am delighted to announce to you that the 2nd project has been finished and after ten (10) years of diligent collecting effort the CATALOGUE OF EUROPEAN TROPHIES was published in September 2010, that documents the data and contains the photos of European roe buck antlers rewarded with gold, silver or bronze medals. These data help us picture the roe deer stock and hunting of an area, region or a country and their well considered utilization of the livestock.

It also shows the ways hunters manage their roe deer stocks, a game available for hunting purposes.

Out of the hunters associations of thirty (30) European countries approached, unfortunately not all of them had detailed database and given this, our collection is can not be complete.

The data of 17,500 medal rewarded antlers from 21 countries were received and processed.

A few particular data from the catalogue:

Data of 34 antlers are from the years back to the nineteenth century.

The oldest is a still existing roe buck antler dated from 1846 in Germany.

During the French Revolution and the following Napoleon wars roe deer almost fully extinct from Sweden; yet a few species stayed alive in the forests and agricultural areas around Malmö. A map is to show how roe deer has repopulated Scandinavia following 1800 up to these days.

The enormous effort of data collection and processing were made by three committed hunters, namely

Mr. Sten Breith professional hunter, trophy judge of Nordisk Safari from Denmark. He enriched the book with about 5,000 data.

Mr. Burkhard Winsmann-Steins, from Germany, photographer of the Wild und Hund, who illustrated the book with 100 colourful photos.

Mr. László Bozóki, forester, professional hunter and wildlife biologist, who raised the idea of this book and processed, compiled and edited the data.

We will continue to collect data and yearly-bi-yearly the a new volume of the series will be published extended with new data. In order to help our efforts we encourage every roe buck hunter to send the data and photos of his/her trophies to the address below, where the book can be ordered.

We will subtitle the book in German, English, French, Spanish, Swedish or Hungarian.

The photos of the eminent European roe buck antlers are presented in 170 colour photos.

In two years from now, that is in 2012 we plan to offer a volume illustrated with nice photos of the collection of deer trophies of species native in Europe, i.e. Eurasian elk (alces alces), red deer, fallow deer and reindeer to the interested hunters.

Target date for sending the photos is May 31st 2012.

Please do not forget to mark your letter with the legend 'SZARVASOK' (Deers)

Additional volumes of the series:

In 2013 we plan to offer a volume of 'BOVIDAE – MOUNTAIN GAMES', where we want to collect and process data of alpine ibex (wild goat), mouflon and chamois.

In 2014 in a volume titled 'PREDATORS' we will introduce the skulls and skins of predators and WILD BOAR FANGS in a volume.
